We are looking for someone who:

- Can commit to the school year (August-July) and is available to fulfill weekly duties
- Has a strong understanding of normal childhood development and is knowledgeable and skilled in Respectful parenting philosophies and techniques
- Is comfortable and confident about modeling respectful parenting techniques with a wide variety of children
- Is a skilled communicator who can communicate effectively with both children and adults, both one on one and in a group setting
- Feels comfortable with managing conflict in healthy and productive ways
- Feels comfortable in a sometimes chaotic environment and is able to keep a level head

JOB SUMMARY:

Parent Coach will report to the Executive Director and support families in the classroom by playing a lead role in day-to-day activities and modeling healthy conflict resolution. The Pea Pod Playschool runs September 1- June 30th. August includes planning activities for the upcoming year, supervision and coordination of informal play dates at the Pea Pod playground, family orientation, and training. Position also includes activities to keep the playschool running safely and smoothly in the areas of health and safety, discovery/Arts, cleaning and sanitizing, parent education meetings, and environments maintenance
